Please refer to your letter of 4 June 2009.

1. In reply to the questions asked by the NGO Committee vide its letter of 22 May 2009, we had sent in our reply on 27 May 2009 which was as this:

“In response to your letter of 22 May 2009, I have to say that the website in question is not the property of Asian-Eurasian Human Rights Forum nor does it control or maintain the site. This answers your other questions.”

2. Our NGO runs under one name only.
3. We are not part of the website. Website organizers are free to put stuff on their sites. Generally speaking, website organizers approach NGOs/organizations to give them information about their structure, objectives, activities, opinion etc. When we are approached we oblige them within our limits because we adhere to the policy of transparency. It is their discretion how and what they put or do not put on their website. If the World-Citizenship.org/, the website in question, has made a blog for AEHRF it does not mean that the site belongs to our NGO or is a part of it. It is their technical convenience how they utilize space of their site. We are not aware whether there is another organization existing by the same name somewhere.

We hope this will satisfy the Committee.
